Pursuant to paragraph (a)(2) of section 385.214 of Title 18 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife ("CDFW") provides notice that it is a party in the proceeding before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") on the Notice Of Application Accepted For Filing And Soliciting Motions To Intervene And Protests.

CDFW is the relevant state fish and wildlife agency for consultation pursuant to the Federal Power Act section 10(j). (16 U.S.C. section 803(j)).

It is the goal of CDFW to preserve, protect, and as needed, to restore habitat necessary to support native fish, wildlife, and plant species within the FERC-designated boundaries of the Project, as well as the areas adjacent to the Project in which resources are affected by ongoing Project operations and maintenance activities and recreational use.
