

1. For the identification of historic properties of religious and cultural significance to Tribes and Tribal Cultural Properties - any changes to recreational use or new structures should be planned in a way to avoid adverse effects to historic properties, which means that early identification work is needed prior to making any decisions regarding recreational use or design of new structures.

We would like to work with the applicant to identify areas for such survey and the most effective methodologies;

2. Analysis of the cumulative and specific impacts to traditional and cultural sites that will be effected by the raising of the water level, as well as ways to resolve such adverse effects.

3. Involving tribes at an early stage for consultation.

4. The need to rebury cultural items that were recovered as part of previous inventory work.
