Order Approving Revised Exhibit G

(Issued July 25, 1990)

On May 25, 1990, South Sutter Water District, licensee for the Camp Far West Project, FERC Project No. 2997, filed revised exhibit G drawings in compliance with Ordering Paragraph (D) of the order amending license issued April 19, 1990 [[51 FERC ¶62,051](#)].

The revised exhibits show the 1.92-mile-long transmission line removed from the project boundary. The exhibits conform to the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

The Director orders:

(A) The following revised exhibit G drawings filed on May 25, 1990, are approved and made part of the license:

(B) The superseded exhibit G drawings are eliminated from the license.

(C) Within 90 days of the date of issuance of this order the licensee shall file an original of the approved exhibit G drawings reproduced on silver or gelatin 35-mm microfilm mounted on Type D (3 1/4 x 7 3/8) aperture cards for each drawing. In addition, the licensee shall file two Diazo-type duplicate aperture cards. The original set and one duplicate set of aperture cards should be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. The remaining duplicate set of aperture cards should be filed with the Commission's San Francisco Regional Office. The FERC drawing numbers (2997-5 through 2997-7) shall be shown in the margin below the title block of the microfilmed drawing and also in the upper right corner of each aperture card. The top lines of the aperture cards shall show the FERC exhibit (i.e., G-1 through G-3), Project Number, Drawing Title, and date of this order.

(D) This order is issued under authority delegated to the Director pursuant to section 375.314 of the Commission's regulations. Section 385.1902 of the Commission's regulations provides 30 days from the date of this order for an appeal to the Commission of this action. Filing an appeal does not stay the effective date of this order or any date specified herein.
