Pursuant to Section 4.50 of Title 18 of the Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.), the South Sutter Water District (SSWD), as owner and operator of the Camp Far West Hydroelectric Project (Project), FERC Number 2997, files with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) the attached Application for New License Major Project – Existing Dam (Final License Application, or FLA).
