

***Endangered Species Act-listed Plants Study***  
**SUMMARY**

Consistent with Section 6.0 of the *Endangered Species Act-listed Plants Study Plan* (Plan) that was filed with FERC on January 9, 2017,<sup>1</sup> the SSWD provides the following summary for the *Endangered Species Act-listed Plants Study* (Study). The summary includes a description of the work completed to date, key findings, variances, and remaining work. Links to associated data files are also included. SSWD considers these data to be public.

**Work Completed as of 3/1/18:**

SSWD has completed the Study. Specifically, SSWD completed Step 1 (Gather Data and Prepare for Field Efforts); Step 2 (Conduct Field Surveys); and Step 3 (QA/QC) of the Plan. Since no ESA-listed species were observed during surveys, there was no discussion with SSWD operations staff (per Step 4 of the Plan) regarding Project O&M.

Surveys were conducted for ESA-listed plants within the Study Area which encompassed four areas: 1) the North Shore Recreation Area (NSRA); 2) the South Shore Recreation Area (SSRA); 3) the Camp Far West Dam and associated dikes and Spillway; and 4) the Camp Far West Dam Powerhouse, for a total of 505 acres from April 14 to July 27, 2017 and from April 14, 2017 to July 27, 2017.

**Key Findings:**

There were 206 species of plants identified during the surveys and none were ESA-listed species.

**Associated Data Files:**

There are no files associated with this summary since no ESA-listed plants were observed during surveys.

**Variances from Study:**

None.

**Remaining Work:**

None.
